Supplies and Tools Checklist: for each participant

- Clay: **2 boxes** per person (this is a rough estimate again, depends on each participant's production) Any good mid range or highfire handbuilding clay. I will be using Darcy's Majolica with Mica, Cone 04.
 1 box cheap clay for making molds

- Wooden board each (minimum 20" square) with laminated or smooth surface for casting plaster
- Pottery plaster #1- 1 bag will be plenty
- small piece of drywall board, edges taped at approx. 2 ft x 2 ft.
- wooden Cottles for plaster (see diagram supplied)
- C-Clamps- 4 per cottle set
- SKETCHBOOK
- Dust Respirator (mandatory)
- Work Apron or workshirt
- Rubber kitchen gloves
- Old towel
- Fettling knife
- Rubber Rib
- scoring tool... a small shrimp or cocktail fork works well.
- thin dowel at 1/4" thick and 12"length
- big cleanup sponge
- ruler
- texture tools, carving tools
- several pens
- scribing tool to carve plaster, or any hard tipped tool to scribe plaster surface
- small ratty brush
- rolling pin - small kitchen variety is fine
- several small plastic containers with lids
- plastic to cover wet work
- large pail for mixing plaster
- several sheets of wet and dry sandpaper (400 grade)
- Surform (Rasp)
- metal scraper
- some kind of banding wheel or lazy susan
- bucket, sponges and old towels for clean-up

4 L-shaped pieces as illustrated
Height: 4 to 5 inches
long length: 18" inches
short length: 4 inches
