Metalsmithing for the Imaginative Artist – Crys Harse

Student Supplies

- extra-fine “Sharpie” permanent marker
- paper, pen & pencil
- compass (for drawing circles, not finding North)
- scissors
- “UHU” glue stick
- 2 rolls of ¾" masking tape
- 2 rolls of ½" masking tape
- medium size regular screwdriver
- small ball-peen hammer
- tin snips (aviation type are best) in good condition
- Metal centre punch or sharp pick
- assortment of small fine files, if you have any
- small pliers without teeth (you can get these at Canadian Tire)
- 1/8" new drill bit for metal and a couple of smaller sizes
- wet/dry sandpaper (black, 220 & 400--two sheets of each)
- 2 paint stir sticks
- 3 old towels
- ice cream pail
- a small amount of acetone
- Ajax or Old Dutch powdered cleanser (not Comet)
- small water-colour paint brush
- dust mask
- ear protection
- rubber gloves
- apron
- clear safety glasses

Please wear cotton clothing and closed-toed leather shoes as we often work with red-hot metal
