

## **MISSA 2010 Student Supplies Beginners Chain Jewelry – Julia Lowther**

### Basic Supply List (each student should have):

- 1 pair chain-nose pliers (with springs)
- 1 pair flat-nose pliers (with springs)
- 1 pair round-nose pliers
- 1 pair side-cutters
- 1 jeweler's saw (2"-3" throat, or smallest throat available)
- 1 pkg (doz.) 2/0 jeweler's saw blades
- 1 stainless steel crochet hook (around 2mm size)
- 1 small hammer (picture hanging, tack, ball peen, etc. – *optional*, bring one if you already have one)
- a few favorite beads (to embellish ends of earrings)
- a piece of dark leather or felt, approx. 8 1/2" x 11" (small dark colored hand towel also works)
- small containers (2-3) to hold cut rings
- candle stub or small lump of beeswax
- masking tape
- marking pen
- reading glasses (if you need a little help to see close hand work clearly ☺)
- clamp-on task light (*optional*, but can be very helpful)
