Student Supplies:

- 100 pounds of Aardvark Coleman Porcelain or Laguna B-Mix
- general assortment of throwing & trimming tools
- ribs: I recommend rectangular and round metal ribs. Bring your favorites.
- large sponge: I cut them up into smaller sections. Cheaper!
- needle tool
- wire cutter
- fettling knife
- trimming tools: small for detailed carving and medium to large for trimming on the wheel
- 1 gallon plastic bucket for throwing water
- x-acto knife: a few new blades and some old dull ones.
- hole punches, various sizes
- hand held roller for small slabs
- sketchbook
- Modelling tools: your favorite carving tools.
- 4 small ware boards (1x2 feet approximately)
- 5 Throwing Bats (10 inch diameter)
- Sharpies, small to medium
- Thin plastic wrap
- Small, medium bamboo brushes
- wide bamboo brushes
- cheap small and medium brushes (any kind) for hot wax
- Sponges and buckets for clean-up
- Old hand-towels
- Rolling Pin
