NEW THIS YEAR: MISSA's very own sketchbook.

Sturdy, natural cover, coilbound at top; 75 sheets of acid-free, heavyweight 70 lb. paper with medium texture. Works well with pen and ink as well as any dry media and offers great erasability. 10" x 7"

Cost: \$12.00

- Old electric frypan or griddle, never to be used for food again.
- Torch...Benzomatic TS200, or other type. MUST have automatic start and be totally adjustable.
- 8-12 Assorted NATURAL bristle brushes. Dollar store, 1/4-1" and larger. No synthetics. Never to be used for other mediums again.
- 1-2 cheap HAKE brushes. Never to be used for other mediums again.
- Extension cord
- Blue or green low tack masking tape
- 3-6 rolls paper towels
- 3-4 newspapers
- LOTS OF 100% cotton rags
- Oil paints and/or powdered pigments
- At least 10 soup cans or stainless steel cups. Not aluminum. Dollar Giant has several sizes.
- Xacto knife or snap off blade knife
- Ruler
- Surgical gloves (several pairs)
- Acrylic Gel (medium consistency)
- 1 lb. canning paraffin (hardware or grocery store)
- Clip board or 3 hole notebook to keep handouts together, & paper for notes
- Images to work from, & some B+W photocopies, high contrast
- Various pottery tools used for shaping and trimming pots (Art supply store)
- Stencils (If you have any)
- Any of the following: Charcoal, 6B graphite, permanent felt pens, oil pastels, oil bars
- Metal items that have pronounced texture to press into wax (like potato mashers)
- Substrates: masonite, MDF board, cradled boards (From art supply) heavy weight illustration board. Please have every thing pre cut to small sizes, 5X7, 8X10, 9X12, 10X14. Bring several, but keep them small.
- Barren, if you have one. There will be some there to use.

- ONLY IF YOU HAVE THIS ALREADY: Tacking irons, Wood burning tools, heated encaustic spatula, dual cartridge respirator with particle filters. Don't go out and buy this stuff. You may buy a 3M dust mask #8210, if you choose.
